Earlier, Dean was Budget Director for the City of Philadelphia. He led the development and implementation of a \$4.5 billion annual all-funds budget for the nation's fifth-largest city, resulting in record levels of fund balance.

In addition, Dean taught at the University of Pennsylvania's Fels Center of Government and served as an evaluator for the Ford Foundation's Innovations in American Government Awards.
